Flower: White (or pink), all year, fragrant

Fruit: Purple drupe

Wildlife: Provides food for birds. Nectar plant for Bahamian swallowtail, Bartram's scrubhairstreak, Cassius blue, Dorantes longtail, Florida duskywing, Florida white, Giant swallowtail, Great southern white, Gulf fritillary, Hammock skipper, Julia, Large orange sulphur, Long-tailed skipper, Martial scrubhairstreak, Miami blue, Red-banded hairstreak, Schaus' swallowtail, Zestos skipper and other butterflies and moths.
