Pitomba Eugenia luschnathiana



It is an evergreen shrub or small tree growing to 4–10 m high, native to the state of Bahia, Brazil. Eugenia luschnathiana is grown primarily for its edible fruit. This has a thin, tender skin, and a soft, juicy, golden-yellow pulp. It is aromatic, slightly acid and faintly resinous in flavor.

When to Plant: July-August

When to Harvest: About 4 months after planting

Uses in cooking: Jelly, Preserves, drinks
