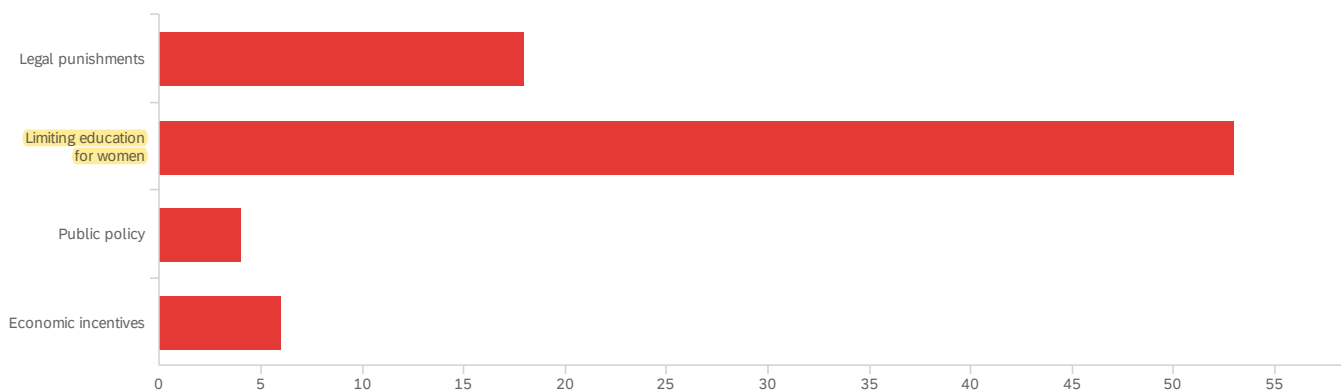

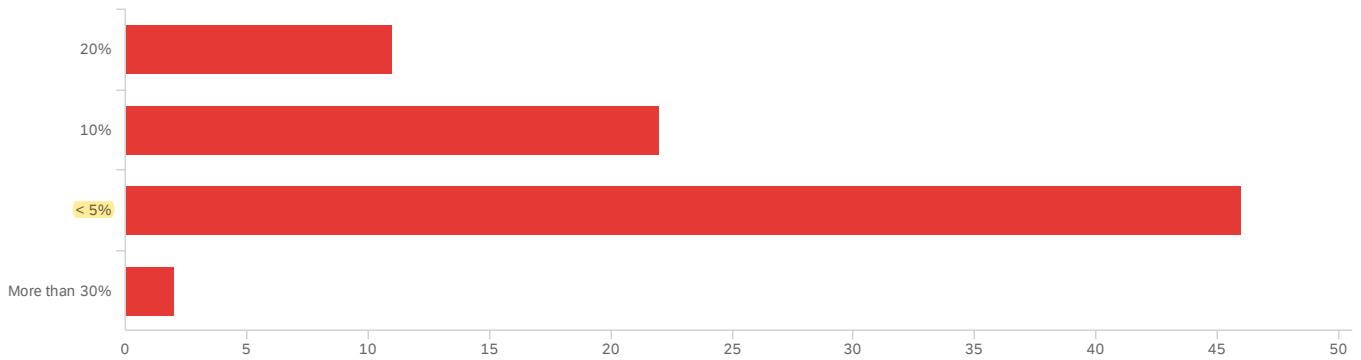
Q1 - Which environmental concern is the LEAST urgent for Southeast Florida?



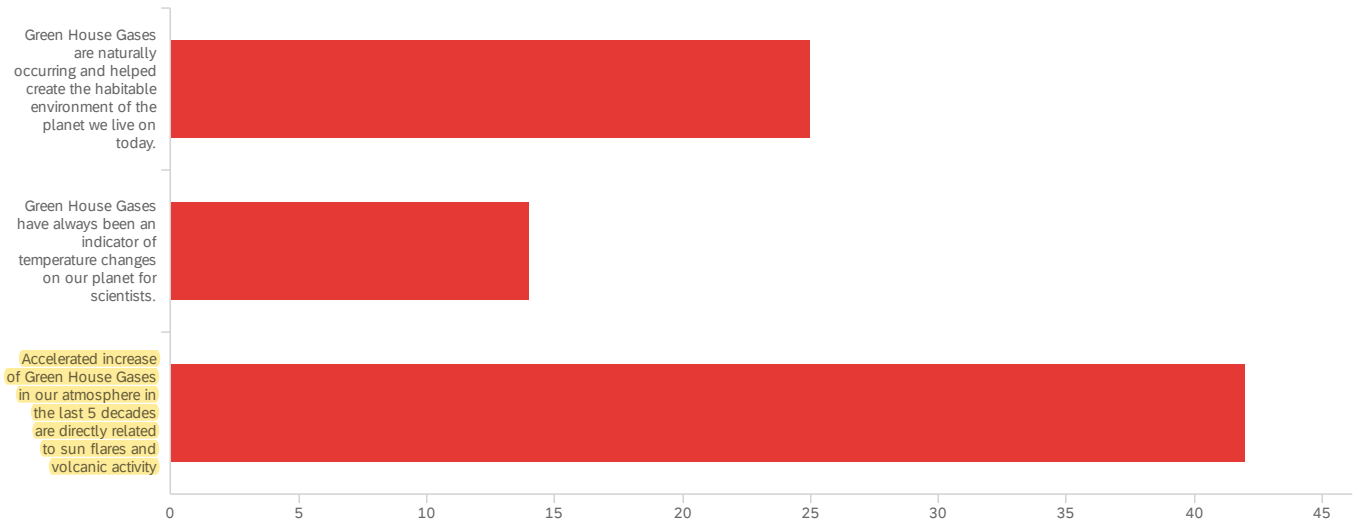
Q2 - Which of the following is NOT a strategy that could slow population growth?



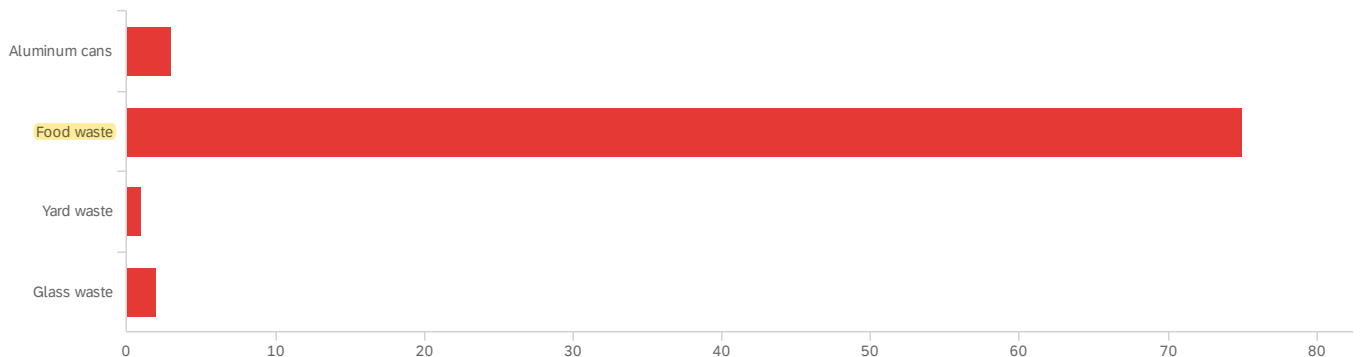
Q3 - In 2019, what percentage of total US Electricity usage was from Solar Energy?



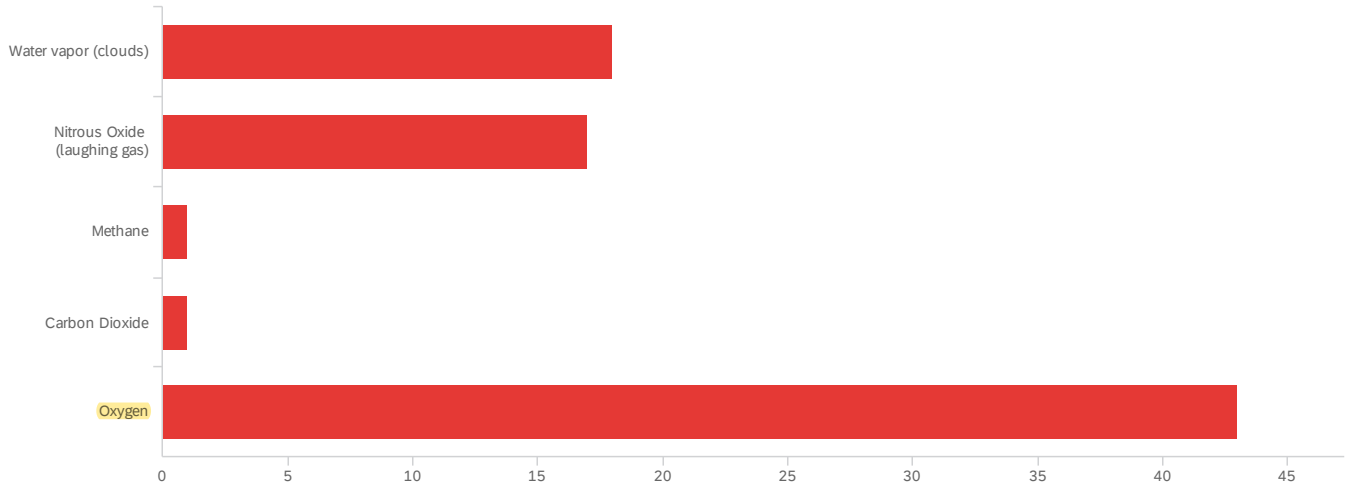

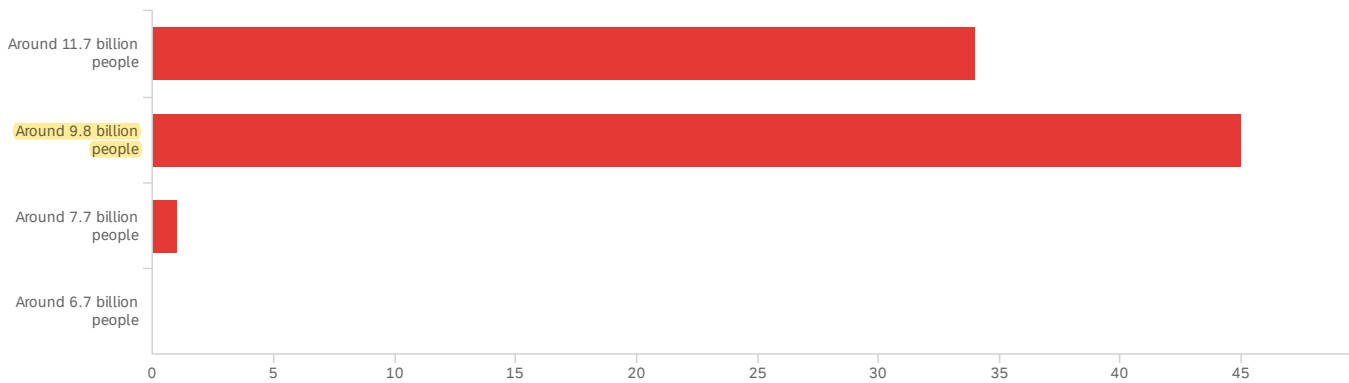

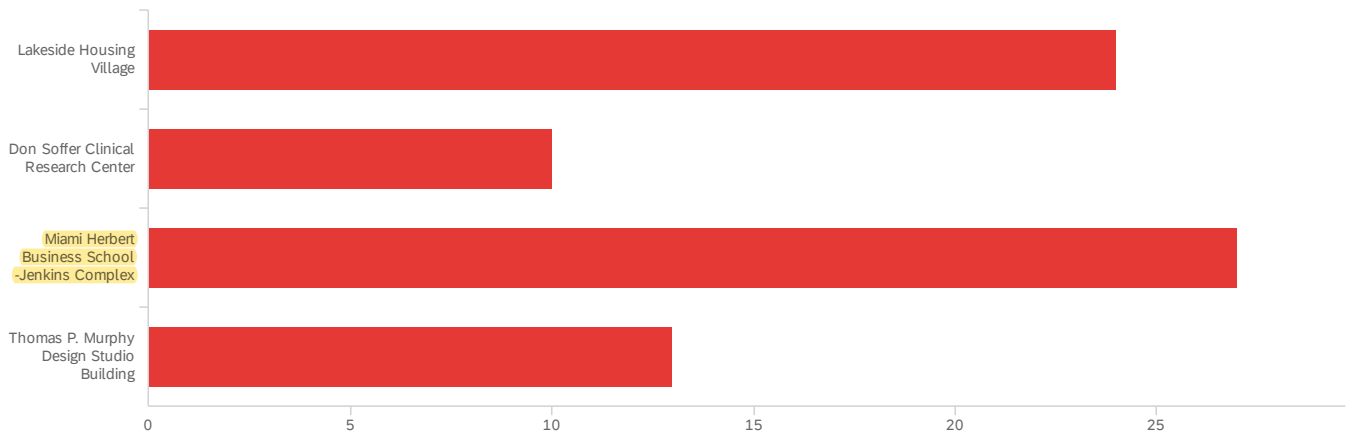

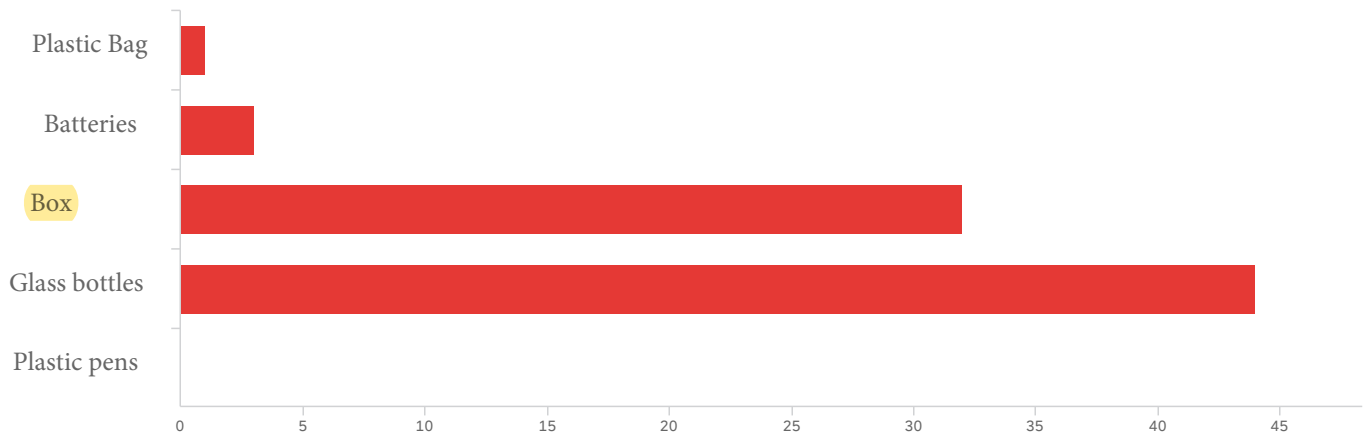

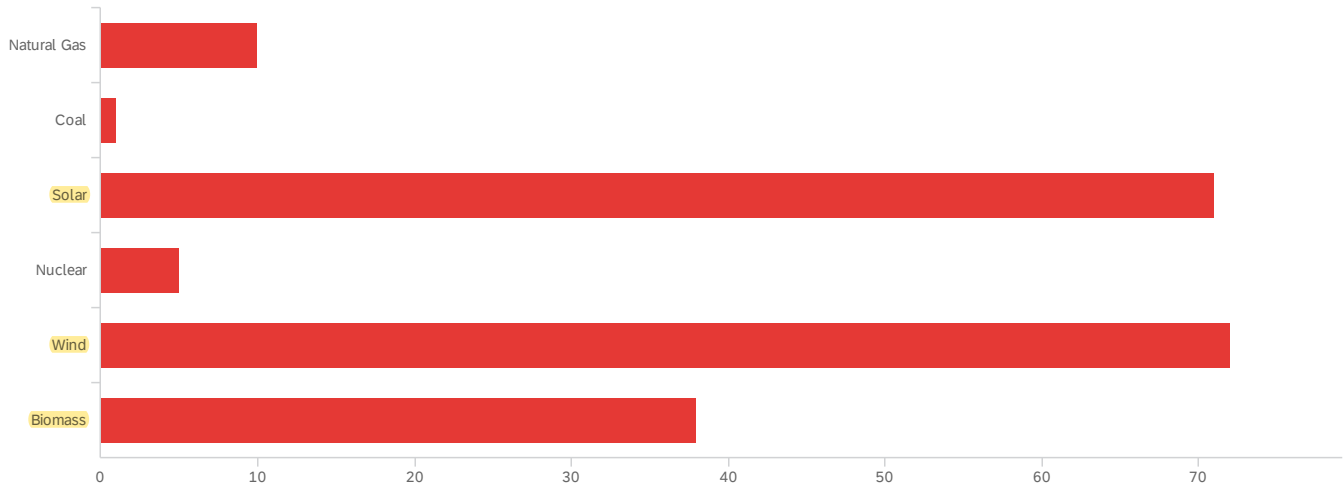

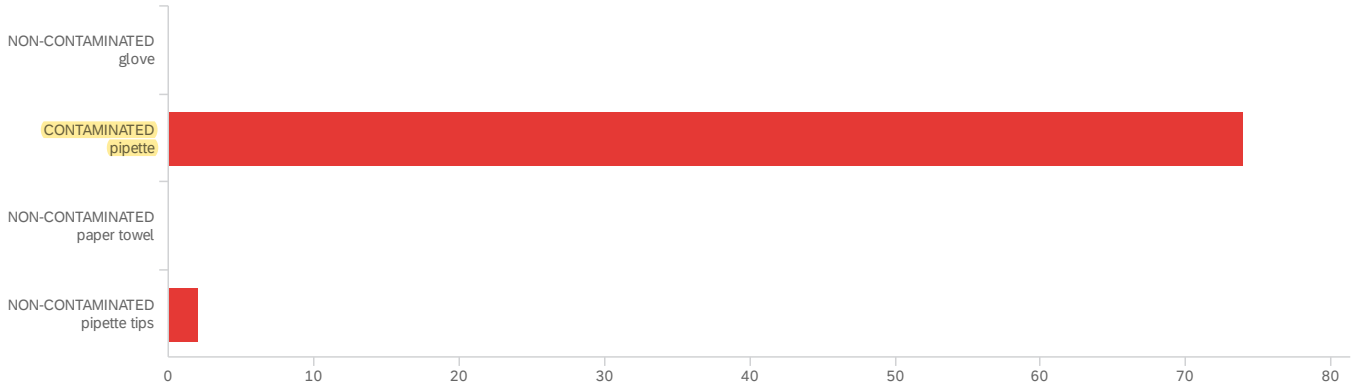
Q13 - What would be considered a renewable source of energy?



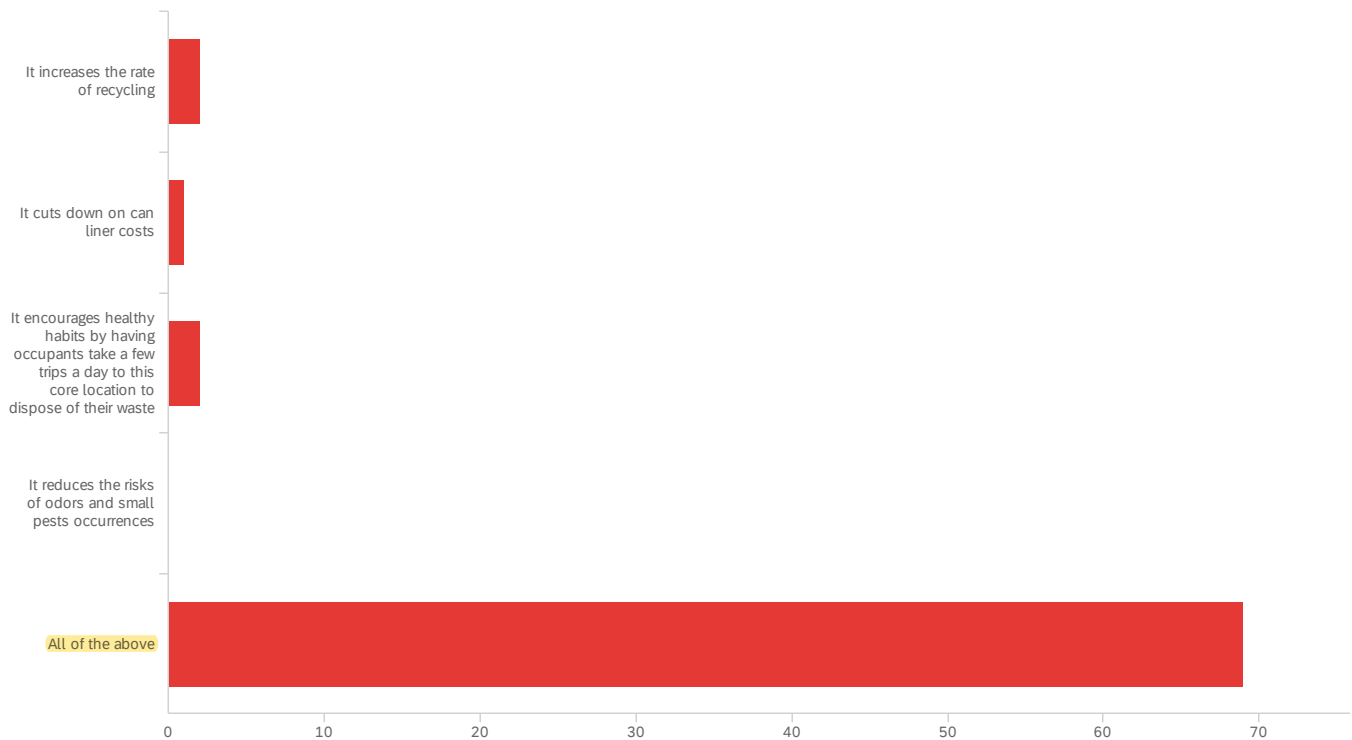
Q14 - Click the images where food waste is being disposed of in a sustainable way



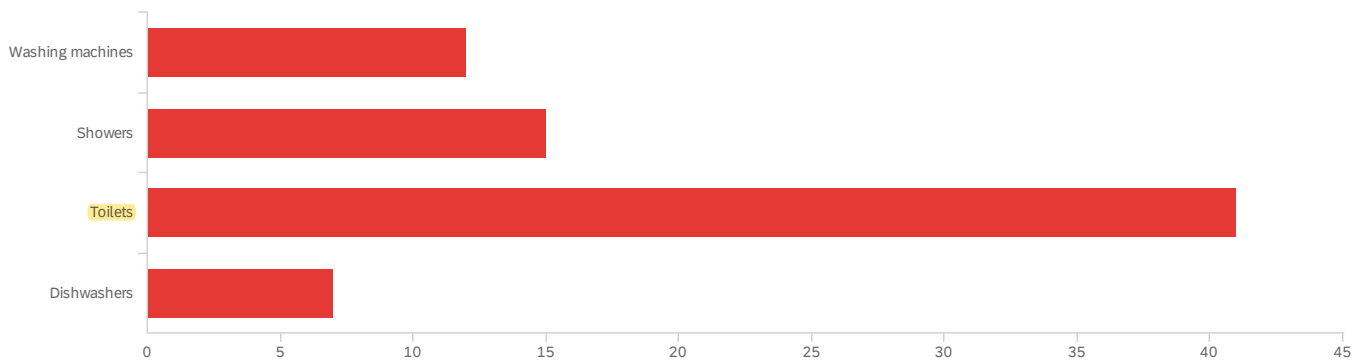

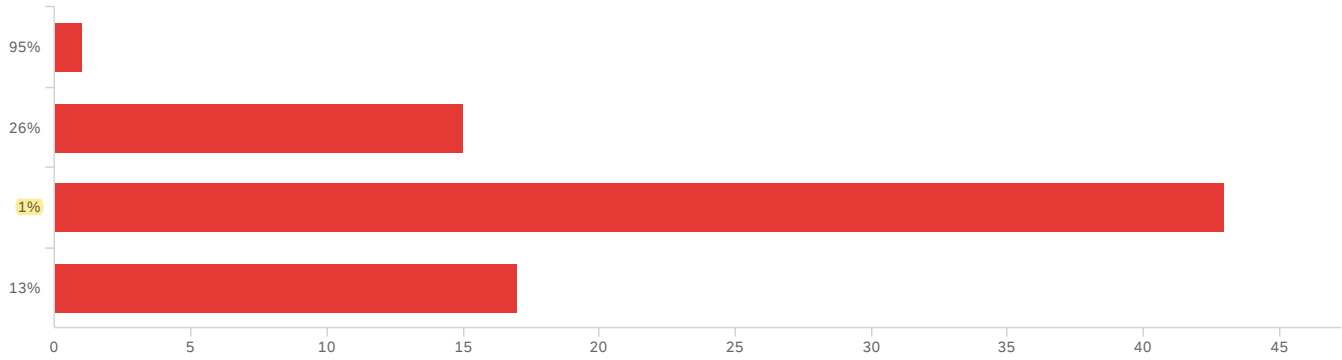
